The statewide network unites 12 member food banks to provide a healthy, adequate, and consistent food supply to every community each day. Each year, the Feeding Florida network provides food to the 2.8 million Floridians facing hunger, including over 850,000 children. Local Young Farmer & Rancher programs volunteer their time to benefit Florida food banks by participating in "gleaning" projects. Farmers donate unharvested product at the end of the season, but this requires volunteers to "glean" or pick the donated items from the field. This allows fresh produce to be sent to Feeding Florida food banks all across the state.

The "Fresh from Florida Challenge" was inspired by one of the state YF&R leadership group who liked the 10gallon milk challenge but wanted to have a positive impact on all Florida commodities. As Florida is in production year round, this ensures that a steady supply of Fresh Florida products are being donated to food banks across the state.

The 10-gallon milk challenge was a national campaign to support American dairy farmers. Florida Young Farmers & Ranchers accepted the challenge all across the state to support Florida's dairy industry. Over 1 million gallons of milk has been donated since the challenge started in 2019.
