Property Protection Plan – General Information and Claim Form

Your Farm Bureau membership in conjunction with posted Florida Farm Bureau purchased “No Trespassing signs” provides a Property Protection Plan.

Florida Farm Bureau will provide a \$500 reward to persons providing information leading to the arrest and final conviction of anyone committing trespass, arson, theft or criminal damage (vandalism) to a member's property.

This benefit is paid to the person who has provided information leading to an arrest and conviction of the trespasser for the qualified charges/crimes. The claimant must have legal right to the land and provide necessary documentation proving the assailant has been charged and convicted of the qualified charges/crimes.

To process claim, please return the following form along with the necessary documentation:

- Claim form (page 2).
- Proof of right:
 - Land ownership, lease, occupant permission from land owner
- Court documentation regarding assailant being convicted of felony: arson, theft, or criminal damage (vandalism).
- Proof of trespass sign posted on property relating to claim.

NOTE: Membership must be in good standing at the time of crime for consideration. One claim may be submitted per membership.
