With clear understanding of the importance of ensuring human safety and controlling access to impacted areas from Tropical Storm Debby, ESF-17 - Animal and Agricultural Issues would appreciate deference in allowing access to areas where critical agricultural facilities are located.

Agricultural service vehicles and agricultural workers require access to facilities to ensure animal welfare, the security of hazardous materials, and to supply food to our citizens.
