Florida Panther Payment for Ecosystem Services Pilot Program Application

Welcome!

Over half of Florida's lands are privately owned, and the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) recognizes the essential role these lands plan in providing wildlife habitat. The FWC's Landowner Assistance Program (LAP) offers technical support to help landowners maintain and enhance these lands for wildlife.

This application is for consideration for the FWC's Florida Panther Payment for Ecosystem Services (PES) Pilot Program, a 3-year initiative providing financial rewards to private landowners managing high-quality panther habitat.

Enrollment is competitive base on the location, amount and quality of panther habitat, as well as funding. To determine if your property is eligible, please refer to the requirements listed below.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible, the area considered:

- Must have at least 500 acres of contiguous property* located in one of the 17 counties (see figure 1 below). *Applicants have the flexibility to determine which contiguous acres of their property they would like to enroll in the program.
- Must be within 2-miles of the Florida Wildlife Corridor* (Florida Ecological Greenways Network Priority 1-3 lands) **Please contact FWC staff if you are unsure if you meet this requirement.*
- Must meet all of the following habitat criteria:
 - Minimum of 10% native forest cover
 - o Maximum of 70% open habitat
 - \circ $\,$ No more than 25% of property dominated by invasive plants.
- Must be owned by a non-governmental entity (private individuals, for-profit organization, or non-profit organization) or American Indian Tribe for private or commercial use.

• May be held under a conservation easement, except if part of an existing easement is required to mitigate loss of wildlife habitat.

Exceptions to the criteria may be considered on a case-to-case basis.
