



NOMINATION FOR 2025 COUNTY ALLIANCE FOR RESPONSIBLE ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP (CARES) AWARD

BACKGROUND

Florida Farm Bureau Federation's CARES program recognizes progressive farmers and ranchers who demonstrate exemplary efforts in protecting Florida's natural resources. Since 2001, the CARES program has publicly recognized more than 900 agriculturalists by highlighting their positive contributions to sustainability. By awarding each farm or ranch with a customized 'This Farm CARES' sign, CARES recipients demonstrate to the general public their commitment to protecting Florida's beauty and natural resources for future generations.

OVERVIEW

The CARES Award selection process begins with a nomination form. Incomplete nomination forms will not be considered. This is a critical step in ensuring that Florida Farm Bureau recognizes CARES recipients for their environmental stewardship. This form can be used to nominate your own farm/ranch or that of a colleague.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRACTICES TO BE CONSIDERED

The nominee's Best Management Practices (BMPs)/conservation program must be in the maintenance-phase where evidence of exemplary conservation practices are observed and then verified by the coordinating agency (i.e.. Florida Department of Agriculture, Natural Resources Conservation Services, Water Management Districts). The nominee must be enrolled in a program for a minimum of two (2) years prior to being nominated. The farm must demonstrate one or more of the following practices for eligibility:

WATER QUALITY

Preserve or improve water quality within or adjacent to an agricultural operation

SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION

• Reduce soil erosion, nutrient depletion, and water consumption; and enhance water recharge

NATURAL RESOURCE CONSERVATION

• Implement practices which prove to positively impact natural resources, such as providing wildlife habitat

PESTICIDE/NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT

• Use pesticides/nutrients responsibly, maximizing benefits and minimizing potential adverse environmental effects

WASTE MANAGEMENT/RECYCLING

 Reduce waste by recycling agricultural by-products and waste products on site

Explain how the business uses new methods, technologies and/or a new combination or application of existing approaches or technologies. Indicate any participation in research and/or community educational program(s) promoting natural resource protection or the use of these practices.

V.LETTER OF COMPLIANCE

This letter should detail the nominee's implemented Best Management Practices and/or conservation program as well as the success and results of their actions taken. This letter should detail the date of the most current site visit verifying implementation and/or compliance record. The letter must be signed by the agency staff member who has worked with the farm/ranch and include the farm's Notice of Intent (NOI).

VI.SUPPORT MATERIALS

Please include the following additional information as support material to complete the nomination:

i.Two letters of recommendation. These letters may be from local officials/staff, fellow agricultural producers, Extension Agents, county Farm Bureau leadership, technical consultants, association representatives or others familiar with the business. The typed letter should detail the representative's contact information,

involvement with the business and his/ her knowledge of its history and success in 1,000 words or less.

Checklist for 2025 CARES Award Nomination
This checklist is required in order for the nomination to be accepted, reviewed and considered for a CARES award. Nominators will be contacted if any items or information is missing. Failure to provide missing items prior to the deadline results in an incomplete nomination.
